



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COMMON CHARACTERISTICS FOR THOSE IN THE RURAL SOUTH

- Older population
- Less people formally educated
- Higher unemployment rates
- · Less wealthy

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- · Poorer health status
- · Less health insurance
- Less public transportation

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THINGS ARE NOT ALWAYS AS THEY APPEAR

CHALLENGES IN RURAL HEALTH

- Rural residents have an age-adjusted mortality rate that is 10% higher than urban residents and 33% higher than the U.S. average
- Many rural counties do not have hospitals and several that do are running an average 12% deficit
- Lack of access to care
